In July 2007, BOMA International launched the 7-Point Challenge to reduce energy consumption in buildings by 30 percent by 2012. The 7-Point Challenge encourages BOMA members to benchmark their energy performance and water usage at least once a year through the EPA's ENERGY STAR benchmarking tool.
