# **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

*The Young Professionals Group of BOMA Greater Phoenix is looking for a candidate to receive scholarship funding to attend a course toward their Real Property Administrator (RPA®) or other BOMI designations.*

## ***Eligibility Requirements:***

In order to be eligible to receive the scholarship, the candidate must meet the following criteria:

- Be under 40 and employed within the industry between one and five years and demonstrate a continued desire to develop self along a commercial real estate career path.
- Maintain an active membership status within BOMA Greater Phoenix for at least one year.
- Have served on at least one committee within BOMA Greater Phoenix for at least six (6) months.
- Comply with BOMI's eligibility requirements to enter and ultimately achieve the RPA designation, or other selected BOMI designation.
- Demonstrate past or present community involvement outside of BOMA Greater Phoenix.

## ***Applying for the Scholarship and Subsequent Selection:***

*To be considered for the scholarship, interested candidates must meet the eligibility requirements outlined above and submit in essay or narrative format, not to exceed 750 words, their passion for the profession and mission alignment with YPG. Final submittal shall also include a recommendation from the applicant's immediate supervisor. Selected applicants will then meet with the selection panel and submit peer recommendation for final determination of the award. Application for the scholarship should be sent to the BOMA Greater Phoenix office by email. Scholarship selection panel will confer and invite the final candidates for interviews by September 30, 2010. YPG will directly disburse the tuition funds to BOMI on behalf of the recipient for enrollment in the class of their choice.*

## ***Responsibilities of the Recipient:***

- *The Candidate receiving the scholarship is responsible for achieving a passing grade on the course examination. Failure to pass the exam after two (2) unsuccessful attempts shall disqualify candidate from applying for future YPG Scholarship monies. Failure to pass the exam after three (3) unsuccessful attempts may require the candidate to repay the Scholarship Funds back to BOMA Greater Phoenix YPG.*
- *The candidate shall be required to attend six (6) YPG meetings during the course of the following calendar year.*
